



National Curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
 - use a range of strokes effectively
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

About the PE and sport premium funding:

- Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of the PE and sport they offer. For swimming and water safety this includes:
 - provide additional swimming provision targeted to pupils not able to meet the swimming requirements of the national curriculum

There were 40 pupils in the 2016-2017 year 6 cohort. Lessons were provided in the summer term for those that were not confident to swim at least 25 metres. A local pool and swim instructor were sourced. 21/40 pupils accessed the additional provision; however after an initial assessment 2 pupils already meet the standard.
